

AUTISM DEMYSTIFICATION COURSE FQA

Question: How long does it take to complete the training?

Answer: This is a self-directed course and as such the participant sets their own pace. Most users average 3 to 4 hours.

Question: How long do I have to complete the course.

Answer: 14 days. You will receive a login email from the Learning Management System (LMS) once you have registered. Once the email is sent you have 14 days to complete the course.

Question: How do I get the implementation materials (Puppet Play, Manual and Colouring book)?

Answer: All these materials and more are downloadable upon completion of the online course.

Question: Do we need to buy or do anything else to implement the program with the children at our school?

Answer: Yes and No. You do not need to purchase anything else. However, you will need puppets for implementing the Pass the Puppet Circle Learning Opportunity. You may purchase the puppets that match the ones in the puppet play or you may use puppets you already have.

Question: Where can I get the puppets for the Pass the Puppet Circle?

Answer: There is a list of places where you can purchase the puppets online in the implementation manual provided as a download upon completion of the course. You may also check with Friend 2 Friend as we do keep a small supply.

Question: Can each participant choose to do the course individually or as a large group?

Answer: This is an individual, self-directed course.

Question: Is the "Demystifying the Classroom" training the same as the BC Capacity Building Program.

Answer: Yes and no. The training entitled "Demystifying the Classroom" is the live version of our online Autism Demystification Course. Therefore, it is provided onsite in your location and presented by the program creator Heather McCracken. It is delivered differently, however, includes all the same learning goals. There are also fees associated with this training session.

Question: Does the Autism Demystification Course prepare us to deliver the puppet play.

Answer: No, it prepares you to implement the program and its six learning opportunities with the children you serve, however, the puppet play is delivered in a video format. Only our [Satellite Partners](#) are trained to deliver our puppet plays live.

Question: I am an instructor at a college. Am I able to offer this online course to my students?

Answer: Yes. Students who are part of a post-secondary institute are welcome to take the course, a small fee per student applies.

Question: I am a parent of a child with autism, may I take the course.
